Upper Basin Access (over the tidal cill)

Access to the Upper Basin is over a tidal cill. This table provides an indication of accessible hours either side of high water based on three different vessel drafts*. Our tidal cill webcam streams a live feed of the tidal gauge with depth shown in feet.
